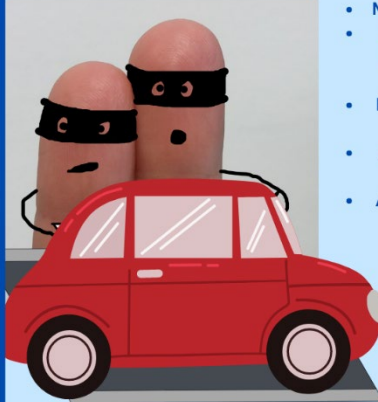

How to Prevent Car Break-ins
